

BODY ART/ TEMPORARY TATTOO APPLICATION & CARE PROCEDURES

Read Instructions First

1. Using a needle or a hobby knife remove inside parts of stencil (if applicable) before use.
2. Clean skin thoroughly with Isopropyl alcohol using a make up pad or pre packed swabs.
3. Ensure skin is dry, apply stencil to body and pat down firmly with palm of hand (choose a part of the body that the stencil will fit appropriately, e.g., small tattoos for small children). Tattoos will last longer in areas that clothing doesn't rub.
4. Shake paint well, until you can hear the beads rattling inside bottle. Apply light coats of paint instead of one heavy coat. After painting tattoo, remove stencil gently by pulling away from skin from all sides and place back onto backing for re-use.
5. Apply talcum powder to entire design.
6. Leave stencil to dry before stacking. (Cleaning of stencils is not necessary but if required clean carefully with a small amount of isopropyl alcohol, avoid rubbing).
7. Keep stencils stored in a flat position.
8. To clean airbrushes and in between colours use isopropyl alcohol.

Please Note: Like all good business you need to re-invest to keep the profits flowing. If you did not get several uses out of one stencil then you may not be using them correctly.

CAUTION: Do not apply tattoos to the face area and never apply tattoos to irritated skin or onto skin abrasions.

HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR BODY ART

1. Apply talcum powder regularly, eg: before sleeping, after showering.
2. Avoid rubbing. Pat dry after showering/bathing. Avoid wearing clothing that will rub.
3. To remove use baby oil or isopropyl alcohol.
